



We have some wonderful answers to prayer to share with you! For nearly ten years we have prayed for God's direction about building a small permanent clinic (most likely in Africa) so that GDMissions could have a more ongoing ministry in that location, and to provide more advanced care. Just recently our Board of Directors approved the proposal to build such a clinic in the West African country of Benin. The chief of the village of Boifo in northern Benin has already donated about four acres of land to a partnering local church there for this facility. In the two past field ministry trips that GDMissions has conducted in this area (September of 2012 and January of 2013) the clinics have been almost overrun with people desperate for care. The closest hospital to Boifo is over two hours away. The next step in the process of constructing a permanent clinic is to gain approval from the government of Benin to establish a local non-profit organization to oversee the clinic operation. Shortly thereafter, on the 15th of June, we will take another GDMissions team to the country of Ukraine for two weeks of dental evangelistic clinics in two locations. Please pray for a smooth customs passing (this can be complicated there) and for open hearts to receive God's word. After years of persecution under Communism, Ukraine is open to the gospel and to those bringing physical help. Please pray for much fruit in a place that was once so closed to receiving either.

Next on our busy summer itinerary is a trip to the Micronesian island of Chuuk, July 2-18. You may recall our adventures last summer that included five days of travel to reach our destination! Our GDMissions team of six will include both medical and dental personnel. The Federated States of Micronesia contain over two hundred islands with about sixty of those being inhabited. With the main island of Weno as our base of operations, we hope to have clinics on two of the outer islands as well. Our long term goal in cooperation with Harvest Ministries in Guam is to see each of the inhabited islands in Micronesia reached with the gospel. So far we have been to about 10 of them.
