So, we boxed up Bible coloring books and crayons for a church lady to use. She wrote, "I came to **Weno** to pick up some things for the family [*They have to go by boat 60+ miles to another island to get supplies and mail.*] and was happy to receive the box. Thank you very much! The children will be happy to receive these gifts. We are finally starting to teach the kids starting from Genesis on."

During a recent one-month trip ministering at churches and Bible schools, Rick received enough Sunday School teaching materials to last at least 3 years, we think. We plan to send at least one year's worth at a time to a church in

Chuuk, Micronesia. A special blessing is that most of the materials are all organized in plastic bags which will keep them dry when they go from island to island in small boats and during rainy seasons.

Rick was blessed not only to receive supplies to send to Micronesia, but to be assured of the prayers of fellow Christians. At one church he preached and/or presented the work of GDMissions on nine occasions. It was his first time to be the main speaker at a missions conference, and he praises the Lord for the opportunity. Since American culture seems to be more and more like Japanese culture in its humanism, the Lord led Rick to preach some of the sermons he developed for Japanese people. Hopefully, this helped the listeners to realize how important it is to start with very basic Bible ideas and attitudes when explaining the Gospel to the lost and untaught. As always, it was a thrill to see the work the Lord is doing in the hearts of American Christians. How we praise Him and hope that our freedom to glorify the Lord continues to be widespread!

We're sure most folks are aware of the devastation from Typhoon Haiyan. As we write this letter, our hearts and prayers go out to the countless Filipinos in the hardest hit areas who are homeless and without basic necessities. One church friend here in St. Petersburg was born on the island that was hardest hit. She received word that all her family survived, but they have no food or water and their homes are "a mess, everything is a mess."



GDMissions feels a special connection with Filipinos because we've been sending dental and medical evangelism teams each year since 2008 to towns and villages on the islands. Also, three of our Associate Missionaries are from the Philippines. A small emergency medical team will go to help local church leaders reach out to families and neighbors in their time of greatest need. We believe that this ministry of comfort and encouragement will meet both immediate needs and prepare the ground for future evangelism. A small team is also the best way to ensure that giving is targeted, effective, and efficient.

We were able to prepare some tracts with the name and address of the Filipino church on them. Hopefully they will go with the team this week. Even though most of the people receiving the tracts may be traumatized at present, hopefully the Gospel message will meet spiritual needs, giving consolation

Benin Clinic

During the GDMissions ministry in Benin this December our mission is planning to meet with officials there to finalize plans to secure land that has been donated for the purpose of building a permanent medical/dental clinic there. This is a huge answer to prayer!

GDMissions has had this burden to build a clinic in Africa for a number of years now, and it's almost hard for us to believe that God is making it possible!

We will be setting up a non-profit organization locally in northern Benin to administer the clinic. Soon we hope to be breaking ground for the start of construction. We would appreciate your **prayers** concerning the **details and funding for this project**. We must move quickly in this heavily Muslim area. Realistically, we don't have funds available to complete this project, but we know our God does. We are fervently praying that He will supply the need in a way that only He can.
