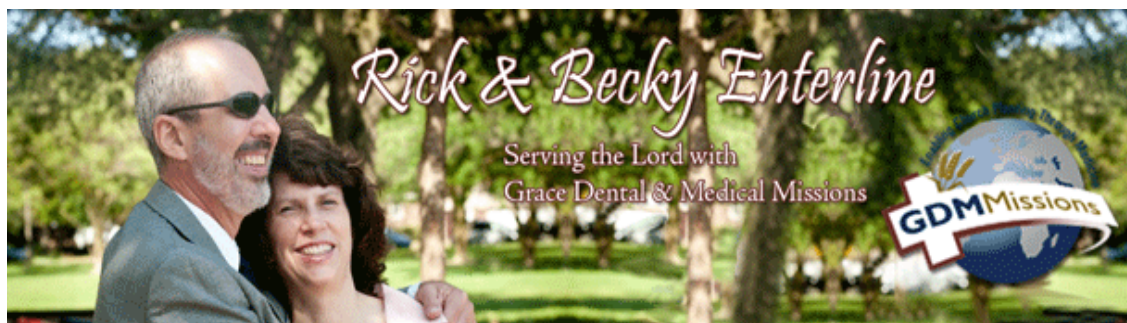

Needless to say, the Chuuk team members all made it safely to their respective homes. Well, it took seven hours longer than anticipated, but Rick finally arrived with all his bags at Tampa International Airport. THANK YOU for your prayers! Now we are all coping with recovery from jet lag - at least Rick is!

It is hard to believe nearly a week has already passed since the team returned from Chuuk. It has been hectic since Rick's return, and we are getting ready to leave for a trip to make contact with new churches on behalf of GDMissions. So, this will be just a brief update.

One of the great blessings of the ministry of Grace Dental & Medical Missions is that we work with national pastors and missionaries on the field. A large group of Harvest Baptist Bible College students from Guam, both past graduates and current students, made themselves available to help with interpreting for the medical and dental workers. Francis (see photo) especially assisted me with preaching and

Our final week in Chuuk we ministered for the first time on the island of Tol. You may recall we had some uncertainty about our reception there. It seemed that some of them at least were genuine believers.

Since returning to Florida, Rick has been busy ordering evangelistic supplies for the next team trip, leaving August 2nd for Benin, West Africa. Please pray for Dr. Jack & Mrs. Jennifer Mitchell, Bryan Bell, Tracy Boutrus and the others on the team. Jack, Bryan and Tracy were on the Chuuk team, and I know that Bryan and Tracy were struggling with colds. Ask the Lord to give Bryan strength and wisdom as he often has to deal with last minute logistic challenges. In particular this time he will be working with the on-site missionary, his brother-in-law Colin Ovenall, to co-ordinate the details of the Benin Clinic project. See www.beninclinic.com.
