He was there in our sorrow as we lost two good friends to cancer; He was there as we traveled and struggled with the physical demands of remote places. He was there in the everyday responsibilities of deputation-type meetings, conference speaking, office work and representing Him in every facet of our lives. It is because of Him being with us that we could do these things in good health and safety. He deserves all the praise for all of it.

In February, we traveled with a GDM Missions team to Hermosillo, Mexico. After three yearly visits to Tres Reinas (a small village on the city's outskirts), a Bible study for those who have been saved has begun. Soon, Lord willing, a church will be planted. Evangelistic clinics were held in two new locations and many heard the gospel there. Those showing interest have been contacted and given further teaching.

In July, a dental team of two (us!) worked on three islands in the Chuuk chain of islands of Micronesia. Tonoas, was a new island for us and resistant to the gospel in the past. We were warmly welcomed, the gospel was shared, people were

In August, Jack traveled to Benin, West Africa with a GDM Missions team and saw the blessing of a nearly completed medical clinic in the midst of an unreached people group. As outreach clinics were held in other locations, people in deep darkness and hostile to the Christian faith, heard each day how to be saved. Only God could do that!

Thank you so much for standing with us in 2015 as we traveled and worked by faith in the great God who gave His Son for us and for those in remote places around the world. In January we head out again back to Benin. We can always use your prayers.
